We welcome people at every stage on life's journey and support them to live in a world of equal rights and opportunities, where they feel valued for their contribution and face no barriers to their progression and success.

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Youth Aliyah Creating safe futures for **Vulnerable Children** in Israel.

Youth Aliyah continues to respond to urgent needs, offering safety, education, and hope for vulnerable young people across its network of youth villages in Israel. Since October 2023, the challenges facing children at risk have only intensified. At Talpilot Youth Village, an emergency children's centre has been opened to give a safe home to the youngest and most vulnerable—those orphaned or removed from unsafe environments. Within this unique "foster family" framework, children receive not only shelter and protection, but also professional therapy, emotional support, and education in a caring environment.

Youth Aliyah also honours the memory of Jake Marlowe z"l, tragically killed at the Nova Festival while protecting others. The Jake Marlowe Memorial Scholarship provides life-changing opportunities for young graduates, giving them the chance to pursue further education and careers, while ensuring Jake's values and courage continue to inspire.

Alongside these projects, therapeutic support is being expanded for children traumatised by war, including those who fled Ukraine and are now living through further conflict. In addition, youth villages are renovating bomb shelters to make them safe, comfortable spaces where children can find reassurance and distraction.

This Yom Kippur, please help us to ensure these children are given not just survival, but dignity, belonging and a future filled with hope.

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
